



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW AND INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

### NAPA SANITATION DISTRICT

### MST RECYCLED WATER FILL STATION PROJECT

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Napa Sanitation District (District) has prepared an Initial Study/CEQA Checklist for the above-referenced project. The Initial Study determined that the Proposed Project, as amended by the included mitigation measures, will not have a significant adverse effect on the environment. The District intends to adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the Proposed Project.

**General Project Description:** The District proposes to construct and operate an automated recycled water fill station on a vacant lot on the eastern portion of property owned by the Napa Valley Unified School District at the Silverado Middle School (the Project). The purpose of the Project is to provide recycled water to contracted customers for agricultural and other uses in the Milliken-Sarco-Tulocay (MST) area of Napa County. The Project site is located in the Coombsville area on the eastern edge of the city of Napa with a small portion of the Project extending into Coombsville Road in the Napa County right-of-way. It would include extension of 70 linear feet of recycled water pipeline, an automated recycled water fill station, and associated mechanical equipment, electrical connection and/or small solar installation, electronic card reader, and security fencing.

**Potential Project Impacts:** The Project's potential adverse impacts related to air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, hazards and hazardous materials, tribal cultural resources, and utilities and service systems will be mitigated to a less-than-significant level with implementation of the mitigation measures included in the MND.
