Special Services Contractor
Insurance Requirements

Insurance Requirements: Without limiting the CONTRACTOR'S indemnification provided herein, CONTRACTOR shall maintain in effect at all times throughout the period of this Agreement, the following policies of insurance placed with insurers with a current A. M. Bests Rating of no less than A: VII or its equivalent against injury/death to persons or damage to property which may arise from or in connection with the activities hereunder of CONTRACTOR, its agents, employees or subcontractors.

Certificates of all such insurance and original endorsements for additional insured and waiver of subrogation requirements, executed by the insurer in form satisfactory to DISTRICT, shall be furnished to DISTRICT immediately upon execution of this Agreement and prior to CONTRACTOR commencing work.

All certificates of insurance (General, Automobile, and Professional Liability) shall contain the following statement relative to cancellation:

- *Coverage shall not be cancelled, reduced or modified in any respect before the expiration date thereof, without thirty (30) days' prior written notice by certified mail to the named certificate holder; however, for non-payment of premium for policy renewal, ten (10) days prior written notice via certified mail to the named certificate holder shall be provided"*

- a. **Workers' Compensation:** Workers' Compensation insurance in accordance with statutory requirements and Employers' Liability insurance with limits of not less than **\$1,000,000.00**.

The policy shall contain or be endorsed to provide that the insurer waives any right of subrogation it may acquire against DISTRICT, its officers, agents, and employees by reason of any payment made on account of injury, including death resulting therefrom, sustained by any employee of the insured.

- b. **Comprehensive or Commercial General Liability:** Comprehensive or Commercial General Liability insurance, including Contractual Liability, shall be at least as broad as Insurance Services Office Commercial Liability coverage (Occurrence Form CG0001), in the amount of **\$1,000,000.00** per occurrence. If work involves explosive, underground or collapse risks, an endorsement covering these risks must be included. If a general aggregate limit is used, either the general aggregate limit shall apply separately to this project, or the general aggregate shall be **\$2,000,000.00** (twice the required occurrence limit).
- c. **Business Automobile Liability.** Business Automobile Liability insurance coverage, including Owned, Hired and Non-Owned Autos, shall be at least as broad as ISO Form Numbers CA 0001 06 92, Code 1 (any auto), for vehicles used in the performance of this Agreement, with minimum coverage of not less than **\$1,000,000.00** per accident, combined single limit (CSL).

The **General Liability and Automobile Liability** policies shall be endorsed to contain the following specific language:

The Napa Sanitation District (DISTRICT), its officers, agents, and employees are covered as insureds for liability arising out of the operations performed by or on behalf of CONTRACTOR. The coverage shall contain no special limitations on the scope of protection afforded DISTRICT, its officers, agents, and employees.

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
